# Legal Policy Statement on the Handling of Residence Permit Applications on Multiple Grounds and by Individuals Already Holding a Permit

## Summary:

This legal policy provides guidance on how the Swedish Migration Agency should handle residence permit applications made on multiple grounds or from individuals who already hold a valid residence permit. Key principles include:

1. When multiple grounds are cited in an application, they must be assessed together in accordance with the Swedish Aliens Act.
2. If an application is submitted while a similar application is being reviewed in court for the same or overlapping time period, it should be dismissed due to "litispendens" (pending litigation).
3. An application for extension can be reviewed even if a court is simultaneously reviewing permanent residence eligibility.
4. If someone applies for permanent residence separately, without linking it to an ongoing temporary residence permit case, the application should be dismissed.
5. A person with a temporary residence permit who applies for protection reasons still has the right to a status determination.
6. If a person already has a valid residence permit and applies again for the same or overlapping period, the application should be dismissed unless there are grounds to revoke the current permit.
7. If the new application concerns the period after the current permit expires, it may be processed if conditions can be evaluated at the time of assessment.
8. Fees are generally charged for each separate ground, but not in situations where a

decision is made on one and others are irrelevant.

9. Exceptions can be made due to Sweden's international obligations, for instance concerning victims of human trafficking.

The goal is to ensure consistency, legal certainty, and compliance with both Swedish and international law.
