





Spelling changes with past simple

- 1. If the verb ends with "y", we change it to -i and add -ed:
 - Try tried
 - spy spied
- 2. If the verb ends with "e", we add just a "d" (not "ed"):
 - closed closed (NOT: closeed)
 - measure measured
- 3. Double the final consonant if the verb ends in a $(CVC)^*$:
 - plan planned
 - stop stopped


