

The Weather in the UAE

The UAE has a desert climate with hot summers and cool winters. Most of the days are warm and sunny. However, in the middle of the summer, in July and August, it is very hot.

In the UAE, summer season starts in late May and lasts until September. The weather is hot with temperatures that can reach up to 45°C. During the winter season the average daytime temperature is 25°C. The maximum temperature is about 30°C, while the minimum temperature is around 15°C. It is most likely to rain during the winter months. The UAE has an average of 5 rainy days in a year during which there is occasional short rainfall. The UAE's climate is very dry and there are sometimes sandstorms. But it almost never snows.

The most pleasant time to visit and travel around the UAE is during the winter season. The winter season in the UAE is from October to March. This weather is perfect for sightseeing and free time outdoor activities.

THE DEWEY LAKE MONSTER

On the west coast of Canada, there are stories of a very large creature, half human and half animal. Some people call it 'Bigfoot', but there are other names too, like 'Sasquatch'. The descriptions of the creature are all very similar. It is about three metres tall. It stands and walks like a human, but it has thick, dark hair all over its body, like a bear or a gorilla. Sometimes, people take photos or videos of the creature, but most of them are not very clear – and scientists usually say they are fake. People tell stories about meeting Bigfoot, but they probably invent the stories because they want money or attention. For example, a man called Albert Ostman described a meeting with a Sasquatch in 1924: it captured him and carried him to its home. He stayed there for six days with the creature and its family, he said. But not many people believe this story.

However, one story is more believable. It happened in Michigan, USA, in a place called Dewey Lake. In the summer of 1964, a woman called Mrs Ultrup described a meeting with a strange creature. It was about three metres tall and covered in hair. It chased her into her house and attacked her dog. She called the police. When they arrived, there were huge footprints in the ground outside Mrs Ultrup's house. The police photographed the footprints, and the local newspaper reported the events. But this was not the end of the story. Other people in the Dewey Lake area reported seeing the creature. Three teenage girls called the police after seeing the creature beside the lake. Suddenly, the 'Dewey Lake Monster' was on news programmes around the country and people arrived with guns to look for it. But they couldn't find it. To this day, the Dewey Lake Monster is still a mystery. The people at the centre of the stories are certainly not looking for attention or money; in fact, they do not want to talk about their experiences at all.

Earth is one of the eight planets that orbit, or travel around, the Sun in the solar system. It is the third planet from the Sun. Earth travels around the Sun at an average distance of about 150 million kilometers. It appears bright and bluish when seen from outer space. Earth is the only planet in the solar system that can support life. Life is possible on Earth because the planet has water on its surface and oxygen gas in its air. Earth also has the perfect range of temperatures for life. It is not too hot, like Venus, and not too cold, like Neptune. The average temperature on Earth is about 15° C. Earth is the fifth largest planet in the solar system.

It is made up of three layers: the core, the mantle, and the crust. The core is the center of the planet. It is about 6,900 kilometers across. The core is very hot. The mantle covers the core.

It is about 2,900 kilometers thick. The crust is Earth's thin, rocky outer layer. At its thickest the crust is about 31 kilometers thick. Plants, animals, and people live on the crust. Land covers about 30 percent of Earth's surface.

The land is divided into seven huge pieces called continents. These continents are Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australia, Europe, North America, and South America. Water covers about 70 percent of Earth's surface. This water is in the form of oceans, rivers, lakes, and groundwater. The four major water bodies on Earth are the Arctic, Atlantic, Pacific, and Indian oceans.

They surround the continents. Some water is frozen. For example, there are large ice sheets in the Arctic and Antarctic regions. The layer of gases surrounding Earth is called the atmosphere. This is the air that living things breathe.

Earth's atmosphere goes up to a few hundred miles above the surface. The atmosphere gets thinner as it gets farther from the surface. It contains mostly water vapor and the gases nitrogen (77 percent) and oxygen (21 percent).
