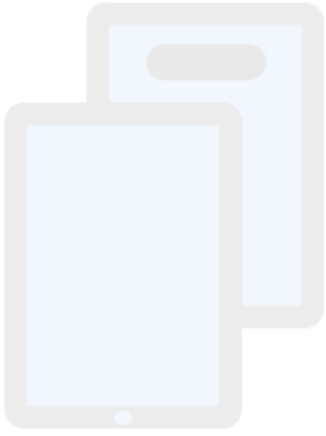

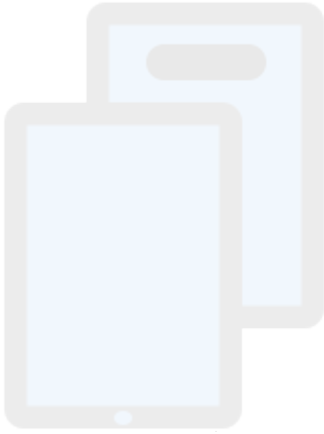

A - Mars

Mars is called the "Red Planet". It is the fourth planet from the sun. It is about 228 million kilometers from the sun. It is smaller than Neptune but bigger than Mercury. Mars does not have any rings, but it has two moons. Its surface is rocky and covered in dust. It also has the tallest mountain in the solar system. The mountain, called Mons, is over 21 kilometers high. One year on Mars is like 687 days on Earth.

B - Mercury

Mercury is the closest planet to the sun. It is about 58 million kilometers from the sun. It is the smallest planet in the solar system. It is about the same size as our moon. It does not have any rings or moons. Like Mars, it has a rocky surface. However, there is no dust. A year on Mercury lasts for 88 days, whereas a day on Mercury is the same as 59 days on Earth. During the day, Mercury is really hot, but at night it is very cold. This is because it has no atmosphere to keep the heat in.

C - Neptune

Neptune is called the "Blue Giant". It is the farthest planet from the sun. It is about 4495 million kilometers from the sun. It is larger than Mars and Mercury. It has six rings and 14 moons. The surface is made of water and gas, but it has a solid middle. A year on Neptune is the same as 164 years on Earth, whereas a day is about 17 hours. Neptune is very cold and has really bad weather with very strong winds and really bad storms. One storm was the same size as the Earth!

The Fennec Fox

The Fennec fox lives in the deserts of North Africa and Saudi Arabia. It is the smallest of all foxes. It can grow up to 40 centimeters long and 20 centimeters tall. However, they have very big ears.

These ears are about 15 centimeters long. They help them lose body heat and provide great hearing. Their hearing is so good that they can hear insects walking on the sand and small animals moving under the ground.

The Fennec fox has lots of sand colored hair that reflects heat from the sun keeping it safe in the day. It has a long tail that helps it change direction when it is running. It even has hair on its feet to protect it from the hot sand. The fox uses its feet to make its home as they live under the ground.

The fox lives between 12 and 16 years long. It is a nocturnal animal, that means it comes out at night and hides from the hot sun in the day. The Fennec fox is an omnivore. It eats meat, eggs and plants. It gets enough water from the plants and fruit it eats, so it does not need to drink water.

Roald Dahl

Roald Dahl was born in the United Kingdom, in 1916. His parents came from Norway and moved to Britain before Roald was born. At home he spoke Norwegian with his parents and his sisters, but at school he used only English. He went to several different schools, but he was not a good student. He was afraid of older boys during this time and often felt scared.

After leaving school he had several different jobs. During this time, he learned to fly an airplane. He got an award for bravery because he helped people in the war.

His most famous book, *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, was published in 1964. It is still very popular. Chocolate was one of Roald's favourite foods and as a child he dreamed of being a chocolate producer. Many people know the story because they have seen the movie.
