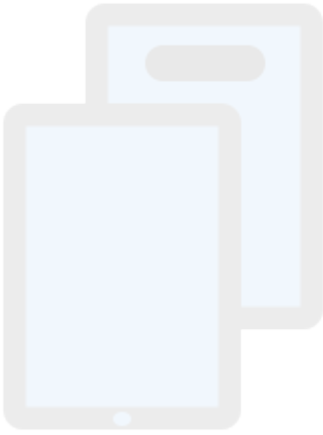

The climate of the UAE is a desert climate with hot summers and cool winters. Most of the days are warm and sunny. However, in the middle of the summer, in July and August, it is very hot.

In the UAE, summer season starts in late May and lasts until September. The weather is hot with temperatures that can reach up to 45°C. During the winter season an average daytime temperature is 25°C. The maximum temperature is about 30°C, while the minimum temperature is around 15°C. The UAE's climate is very dry. There are sometimes sandstorms, but it almost never snows. It rains mostly during the winter period. The UAE has an average of 5 rainy days in a year with the occasional and short showers of rain.

The most pleasant time to visit and travel around the UAE is during the winter season. The winter season in the UAE is from October to March. This weather is perfect for sightseeing and free time outdoor activities. The spring and autumn months can also be great times to visit the UAE.
