They walked **quickly** to catch the bus.

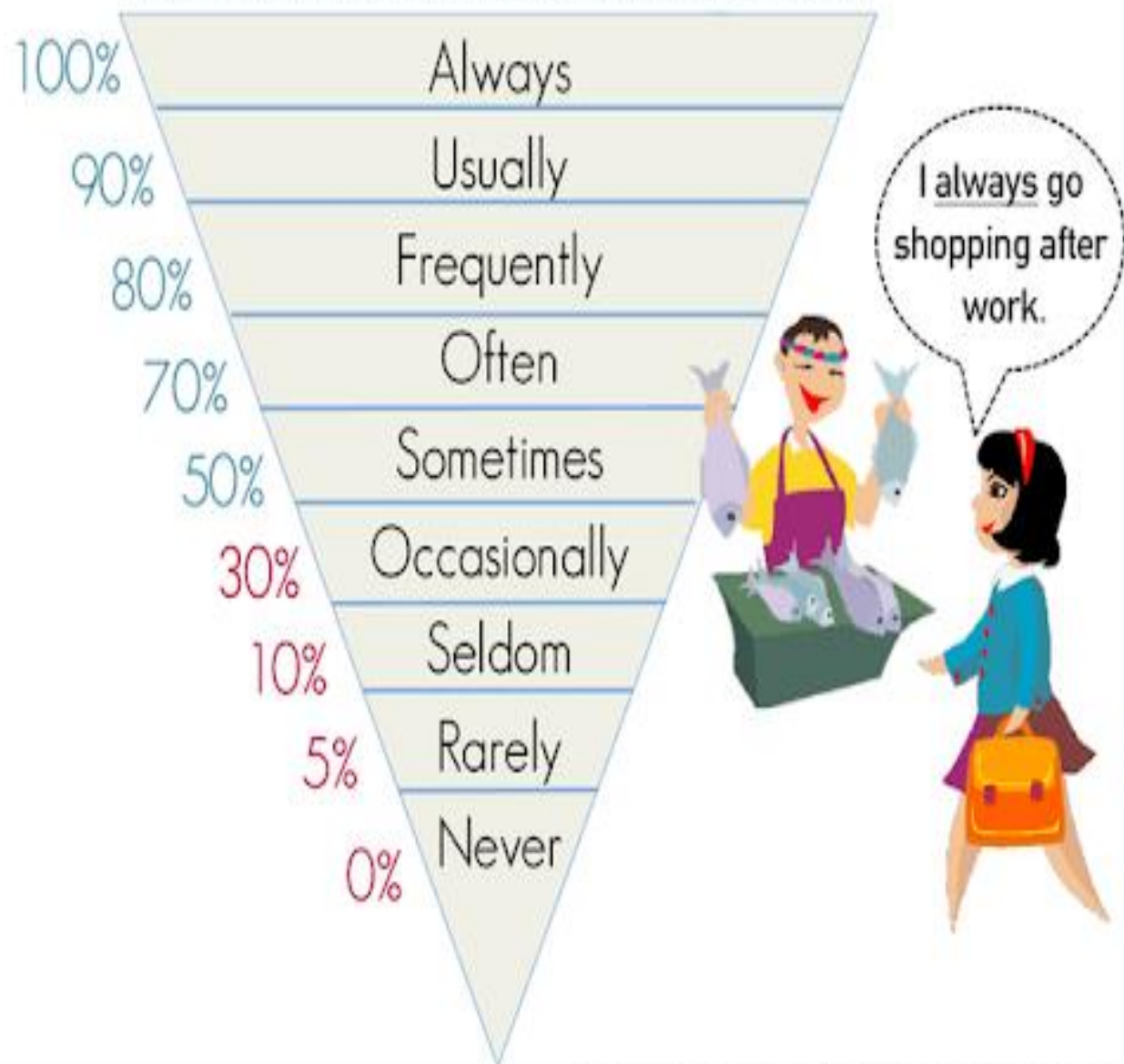

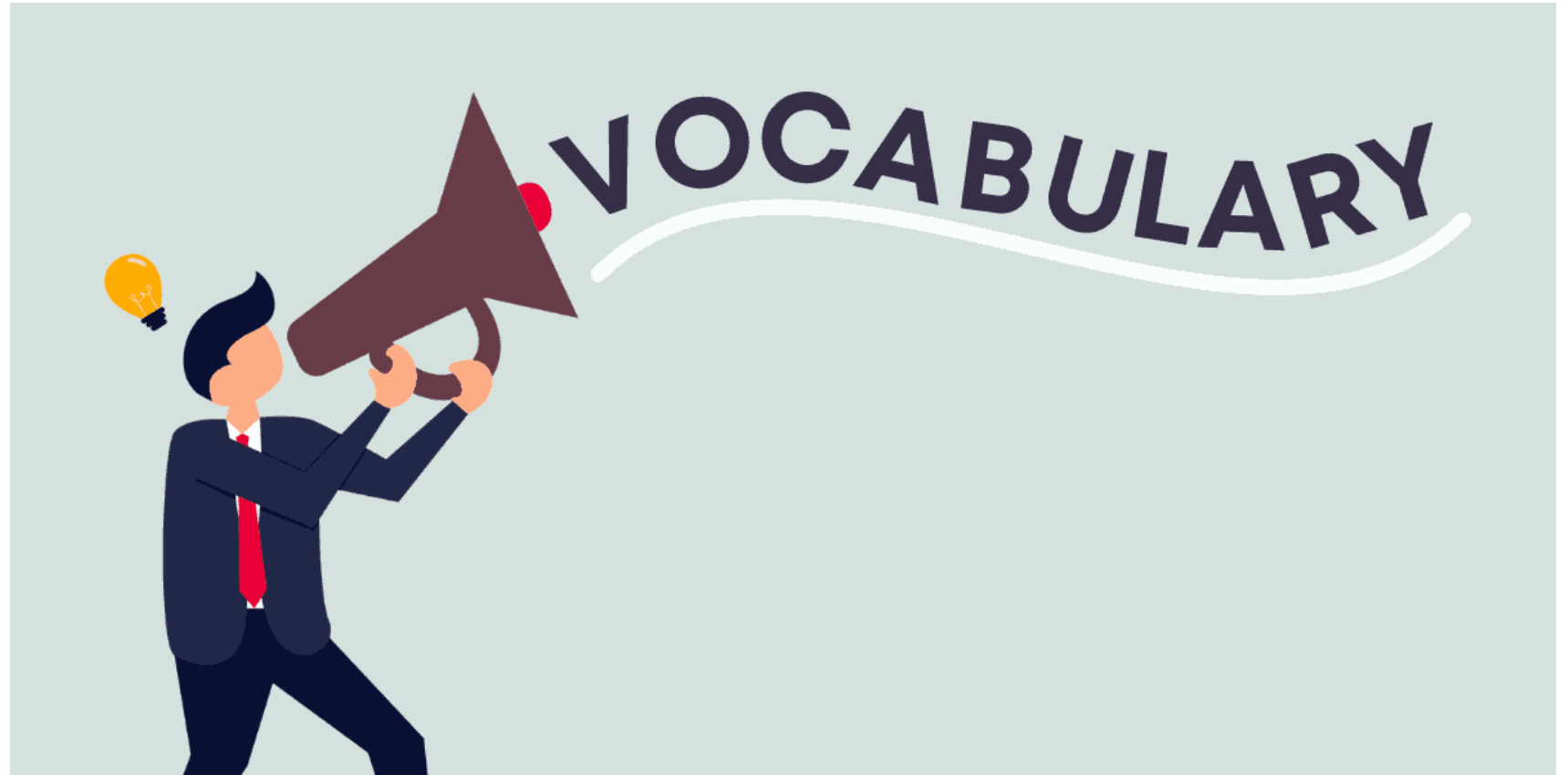

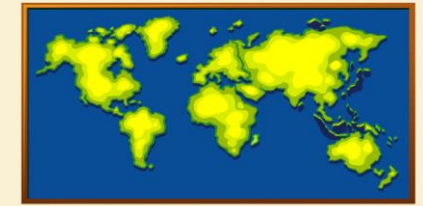
